f the five versions of this new

range from Marshall, three are

result. These are the 100, 80 and 40 watt

models - on the smaller 20 and 10 watt

there isn't a bottle in sight!

While it's true that I could reasonably be

accused of being a dyed-in-the-wool valve

fan of some years' standing, I have to

admit that there are certain sounds which

fare better through a solid state amp. So, if

the best features of both types were to be

put together properly, the result should

appeal to a much wider section of the

playing populus.

With the Valvestate, Marshall have come

very close to bridging this gap by making
